

Forgood's Privacy Policy

Personally-identifiable contact details, such as an email address, are required to validate user sign up.

A user's email address may be used in certain instances to give notice of activities occurring within that user's account or changes and updates to *forgood's* offering. In the event of a user not wanting to receive such emails, it is possible for the user to adjust his/her privacy preferences within his/her account profile.

forgood will not disclose personally-identifiable information to any third party for marketing, promoting or any other purpose, unless the user has given his/her knowing consent in advance, or it is required by law.

forgood may provide social data i.e. typical user profile and/or user patterns, to third parties either for advertising purposes or for the provision of services by *forgood* or by those third parties.

Standard web technology, known as "cookies", may be used to store small pieces of information on a user's hard drive. Cookies enable users to log in or fill in forms without having to enter information each time a user visits the *forgood* website.
